



## **Online survey on data protection and the new EU General Data Protection Regulation**

**The Centrum für Innovation und Technologie GmbH (CIT GmbH) participate in the EU-funded ERASMUS+ project DataPRO.**

The main objective of our project is to create a common and cross-border professional profile for data protection officers. Linked to this, we want to develop training resources and a common vocational training curriculum for data protection officers. With these results we try to respond to the increased requirements of the EU General Data Protection Regulation.

Within the project, we also want to realize other related goals. Among other things, a curriculum and a platform for sensitizing employees of small and medium-sized enterprises are to be developed. The project partners also want to integrate work-based-learning more intensively into the curricula for data protection officers. In addition, we intend to create a uniform certification system for data protection and would like to establish a methodology for quality assurance and licensing of vocational training curricula for data protection officers.

In order to develop needs-oriented learning materials, we are currently carrying out the demand analysis and thus identify the competences and requirements that data protection officers need in order to operate successfully in our digital Europe.

The survey is of course aimed at current data protection officers, but also at managing directors and all other employees of companies and organisations who process personal data of individuals.
